TODAY'S Opponents





LANGFORD

BETWEEN 1897 AND 1908 FRIENDLY MATCHEE WERE FLAVED BY A TEAM FROM LANGFORD AGAINST OTHER LOCAT VILAGES. HOME GAMES WHEA TH SOOT MEADOW. A COUPLE OF MUNDRED VARDS FROM "THE BOOT" A FORMER PUBLIC HOUSE WHICH STILL STANDS AT THE SOUTH END OF THE VILLAGE. LANGFORD FOOTBALL CLUB WAS FORMED IN 1908 AND COMPETITIVE FOOTBALL BEGAN WITH ENTROP INTO THE BIGLESWIDE AND DISTRICT JUNGE LEADUE FOR THE 1908-1909 SEASON. ON SATURDAY THE ZTH SEPTEMBER, THE CLUB PLAYED ITS FIRST MATCH, BEATING SHEFFORD TOWN 6-2. WE FINISHED INTO IT TEAMS, WITH ONLY SHEFFORD BLOW THEM,

TWO YEARS LATER SHEFFORD WERE TOP AND LANGFORD RUNNERS-UP. THEY FINISHED SECOND FOR FOUR YEARS OUT OF FIVE AND WON THEIR FIRST EVER TROPHY, THE BEDS JUNIOR CUP, IN APRIL 1914 WITH A 4-1 VICTORY OVER LUTON ROSEDALE.

SADLY THREE OF THAT CUP WINNING TEAM, AND ONE OF THE RESERVES, DIED DURING THE FIRST World War. From 1919–1925, and Again From 1935–1949, Langford's Home Ground Was At Vicarrage End, Next to the River IVEL, at the Far North end of the Village.

FROM 1925-1933, LANGFORD PLAYED AT THE LEVS, WHICH WAS MUCH MORE CENTRAL THE BUILDING OF A NEW HOUSING ESTRET ET THE LEVS FORCED THE RETURN TO VICARAGE END. THE INTER-WAR VEARS WERE NOT VERV SUCCESSFUL, DESPITE THE TEAM HAVING SOME GOOD PLAYERS, SEVERAL OF WHOM SERVED FOR MORE THAN TEN VEARS LANGFORD WON THE BEDFORD AND DISTRICT LEAGUE FOR THE FIRST TIME IN 1931-1932, AND AFTER THREE DEFEATS IN THE FINAL OF THE NORTH BEDS CHARTY CUP. LANGFORD COLLECTED THAT TROPHY IN 1523, AND IN 1931. IN 1945 THE CLUB MOYED ROTHORS AGAIN TO THE NEW KING GEORGE V MEMORIAL PLAYING FIELD IN THE CENTRE OF LANGFORD, AND GAINED INSTINT SUCCESS ON THE IMPROVED SUFFACE. A WONDERFUL SERSON BOUGHT THEM THE YOURDE OF THE BEDFORD LEAGUE CAMPIONSHIP AND THE LEAGUE CUP. THIS WAS ALSO A RECORD BERKING VERR FOR THE PLAYERS WITH JOINNY GABITAS AND YOUP CUP LEAGUES AGAIN OF A GAME. SETTING THE STANDING CLUB RECORD.

LANGFORD THEN WON NOTHING UNTIL 1969 WHEN A DEFEAT OF BRACHE SPARTA SECURED THEM THE BEDS INTERMEDIATE CUP. THE MANAGERIL SKILLS OF TWO FORMER LUTON TOWN WINNERS, BILLY WAUGH AND ROLAND LEGATE, BOUGHT THEM A SUCCESSION OF TROPHIES BETWEEN 1969 AND 1976, AND ONLY STEVE NORRIS HAS SUPPASSED THEM.

STEVE'S 1988-89 TEAM REPEATED THE 'DOUBLE' SUCCESS OF FORTV VERIS PRIOR ALBEIT AT A MUCH STRONGER LEVEL OF THE SOUTH MIDLANDS LEAGUE PREMIER DIVISION. AS OF TODAY THAT IS THE HIGHEST LEAGUE IN WHICH LANGFORD HAVE COMPETED.

OVER THE LAST 20+ YEARS LANGFORD HAVE SUFFERED A FEW RELEGATIONS, ENJOYED THEIR PROMOTIONS AND MANY CUP SUCCESSES



THANKS TO THE VISION AND HARD WORK OF THEIR FORMER CHAIRMAN AND PRESIDENT MR TED RUTT,

ASSISTED BY HIS HARD WORKING COMMITTEE, LANGFORD WERE ABLE TO MOVE TO THEIR GROUND AT FORDE PARK IN 1984. THIS IS AT THE SOUTH END OF THE VILLAGE JUST OVER THE PARISH BOUNDARY WITH HENLOW, AND WHERE THEY STILL PLAY TODAY. THE CLUB PURCHASED THE FREEHOLD FROM MID\_BEDS DISTRICT COUNCIL IN 1991.

A NEW 106 SEATER STAND WAS OPENED IN DECEMBER 2007, AND STANDING ACCOMMODATING FOR ANOTHER 100 SPECTATORS A VERR LATER. THE PITCH WAS LEVELLED AND RESOWN IN THE SUMMER OF 2006, AND IS NOW ONE OF THE BEST IN

THE LEAGUE,

THANKS TO THE CONTINUING EFFORTS OF A NUMBER OF COMMITTEE MEMBERS. LANGFORD ARE PLEASED TO HAVE ALSO WON THE LEAGUES SPORTSMANSHIP CUP, WHICH COVERS HOSPITALITY AS WELL AS CONDUCT THROUGHOUT THE CLUB, ON FIVE OCCASIONS BETWEEN 2000 AND 2011.

THEY START THE 2023-2024 SEASON WITH THE MANAGEMENT TEAM OF GRAHAM REYNOLDS, STUART ROBERTSON AND OMAR, THIS WILL BE THEIR SECOND COMPLETE SEASON IN THE POSTS. THEY LOOK TO IMPROVE ON THE FINAL PLACING LAST SERSON, AND THE WHOLE LANGFORD COMMITTEE WISH THEM ALL THE BEST.
