

Huntingdon Town manager Laurence Revell on their 2-1 win against Raunds Town:

"This evening we entertained Raunds Town at the Jubilee.

Like us Raunds have found themselves at the wrong end of the table for the last few years but I'd heard good things about the new crop of players there so was under no illusion that this would be a good test.

We were keen to keep momentum having collected our first points of the season against Lutterworth Ath Saturday and we started brightly creating a number of good half chances but couldn't convert. We eventually took the lead from the spot with Connor Pilbeam netting following a clumsy challenge by the defender. Raunds pulled level with their first effort on goal with a very well taken header, this was only seconds before the ref blew for half time. Great time to score !

Second half was much like the first, we created plenty but just couldn't get get the final touch required to net, that was until Pilbeam added a second with a bullet header. The rest of the second half was a bit of a non event and we saw the game out, taking the points.

Finally it was refreshing to have 3 really good officials, all of whom engaged with the players, explained decisions etc if only we could book them every week !
