THE CLUB WAS FOUNDED IN 1946 AS CHENECKS FC, UNDER THE GUIDANCE OF GEORGE LLOYD, WHO WAS THE WELL KNOWN CORONER SARGEANT OF THE BOROUGH POLICE. THE FORMATION OF THE CLUB WAS TO ENABLE BOYS AT THE RUGBY-PLAYING NORTHAMPTON GRAMMAR SCHOOL TO PLAY FOOTBALL. THE CLUB'S UNUSUAL NAME IS DERIVED FROM THE SCHOOL HOUSES, CHIPSEYS, SPENCER, BECKETT AND ST CRISPINS.

IN 1960, THE OLD NORTHAMPTONIANS ASSOCIATION INVITED THE CLUB TO BECOME ONE OF THEIR Sports Sections, thus chenecks became on chenecks and relocated to the billing road sports ground.

IN 1969, ON CHENECKS JOINED THE UNITED COUNTIES FOOTBALL LEAGUE, WINNING PROMOTION TO Division one in 1973, Finishing as runners up to belsize despite only losing once all season. Success continued higher up in 1978, as chenecks won division one by 14 points. They regained the title in 1980, but could not gain promotion due to unsuitable facilities at Billing Road.

THE CLUB WON THE DAVENTRY CHARITY CUP IN 1985, BUT LOST THE NORTHANTS JUNIOR CUP FINAL IN 1994. THE CLUB ALSO MADE THE DAVENTRY CHARITY CUP FINAL IN 1996, BUT LOST 4-0 TO COGENHOE. IN 2010, THE CLUB WON THE NORTHANTS JUNIOR CUP, BEATING SILEBY 1-0 AT NENE PARK.

NEW FLOODLIGHTS AND GROUND IMPROVEMENTS WERE BOUGHT TO BILLING ROAD IN 2013, LARGELY THANKS TO THE HARD WORK OF CHAIRMAN EDDIE SLINN.

THE CLUB WON THE NORTHANTS JUNIOR CUP AGAIN IN BOTH 2014 AND 2015.

THE CLUB PLAYED ITS FIRST EVER FA VASE GAME IN 2015, BEATING SUN SPORTS 2-1, AND PLAYED ITS First ever fa CUP game a year later, drawing 1-1 with harefield united after securing promotion to ucl division one.

DAVE WHITE TOOK CHARGE IN 2023 AS CHENECKS LOOK FORWARD TO THEIR SECOND SEASON IN THE SPARTAN SOUTH MIDLANDS DIVISION ONE.
